


RABBIT VALIDATION IFORMATION

SWINE VALIDATION FOR COUNTY & MAJOR SHOWS



Swine validation will take place on Tuesday, November 15th from 5:30pm-7:30pm at the ACE Arena. If you plan on showing hogs at County or Major shows you will need to validate on this date. There is a \$5 fee for county validation and a \$5 county show entry fee. If you have any questions, please call 524-1421.

Major Livestock Show Entry Night November 3rd

Major Show Entry Night is scheduled for Thursday, November 3rd from 6pm-8pm at the Extension Office. For the meeting please bring social security numbers. Exhibitors and parents must be present to sign entry cards. Check or money order will only be accepted. (NO CASH). If you plan on entering any major shows in Texas (Fort Worth, Austin, Odessa, Houston, San Antonio or San Angelo) you will need to come to this meeting to complete entry forms and payment must accompany forms. If you cannot make this meeting you must make arrangements to turn in your completed forms by Friday, November 4th. For questions, please call the Office at 524-1421.


Andrews County Food Show is Saturday, November 5th Recipes due in the office by October 14th!
